Break-In Process and Cleaning

BREAK-IN PROCESS

It is common for a new horsehair brush to shed a few bristles during the break-in process. We suggest buffing the bristles back and forth over a soft microfiber or cloth towel to dislodge any remaining loose hairs prior to using it on your pool table.



CLEANING

It is important to clean your brushes after each use. Lightly buff the horsehair bristles over a soft microfiber or cloth towel to remove any dirt, or debris that may be stuck in the brush. It is also important to store the brushes in a dry, cool place. This will help to keep the bristles from drying out and becoming brittle.
