ASSEMBLY TIPS


IMPORTANT! PLEASE READ THESE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS IN ENTIRETY BEFORE ASSEMBLING YOUR PRODUCT.

Estimated Assembly Time: 90 minutes.

- 1. Find a clean, level surface to begin the assembly of your game table. Assembly will require two adults. You may want to carefully cut the four corners of the box so that the bottom of the box can be used as your work surface.
- 2. Remove all of the contents from the box and verify that you have all of the parts shown on the Parts List before you begin assembly. **Note: Some parts are pre-installed or pre-assembled.**
- 3. When installing parts that have more than one screw or bolt, hand tighten all screws or bolts in place before final tightening with screwdriver or wrench.
- 4. Electric screwdrivers may be helpful during assembly; however, please set a low torque and use extreme caution because screws may be stripped if overtightened, resulting in damaged parts.
- 5. CAUTION: THE TABLE IS VERY HEAVY; WE SUGGEST THAT FOUR STRONG ADULTS
 ASSIST IN THE ASSEMBLY PROCESS AND POSITIONING OF THE TABLE INTO ITS FINAL DESTINATION.






TABLE PARTS




STEP 1




Layout the 2 end and 2 side table cabinet components face down.

STEP 2




Assemble 1 side of the cabinet frame at a time, align the pre drilled holes in the side panel with the pre-installed inserts in the end panel, insert bolt #25 with washer #28 through the pre drilled holes and into the pre-installed inserts in the end panel, firmly tighten in place. Repeat this process for the opposite side.




Align the pre drilled holes in a leg with the pre-installed inserts in the end/side panels, insert bolt #26 with washer #28 through the pre drilled holes and into the pre-installed inserts in the end/side panels, firmly tighten in place. Repeat this process for all 4 legs.

STEP 4 CAREFULLY FLIP THE TABLE OVER INTO THE UPRIGHT POSITION

CAUTION: THE TABLE FRAME IS VERY HEAVY; IT IS RECCOMENDED THAT FOUR STRONG ADULTS ASSIST IN FLIPPING THE TABLE FRAME OVER INTO THE UPRIGHT POSITION.




STEP 5




Insert the #6 safety latches into the cutouts located on the cabinet side panel, secure in place with the #27 screws.

STEP 6



Pull all safety latches outward and flip open the end cabinet sections of the table frame to allow room for the installation of the center game surface cabinet.


STEP 7




Lift the center game surface section from inside of the billiard corner pocket areas, align the metal rotation rod with the cutouts located on each end of the table frame cabinet and carefully insert the metal rod into the table cabinet.

Note: After inserting the metal rod into the cabinet, adjust the #29 nut and #31 washer and tighten in place.

CAUTION: THE TABLE IS VERY HEAVY; WE SUGGEST THAT FOUR STRONG ADULTS ASSIST IN THE ASSEMBLY PROCESS AND POSITIONING OF THE TABLE INTO ITS FINAL DESTINATION.




STEP 10



Pull all four #6 safety latches outward to release the game play surface, carefully rotate the game surface to the desired game you want to play – (Billiards or Air Hockey) - press all four of the #6 safety latches inward to lock the play surface in place and ready for game play.

STEP 11



Note: For air hockey table play, insert the female end of the power cord into the power cord socket located at the end table panel, thread the male cord plug through the pre-drilled hole in the bottom of the end panel and into the electrical wall outlet.

CAUTION: This plug must be unplugged and removed prior to rotating the game surface from air hockey to billiards.

STEP 11





Note: The pre-installed felt on the bottom of the striker provides fast easy gliding action while protecting the tabletop surface.



Usage: The striker should be firmly gripped and remain flat on the play surface to avoid potential surface damage and provide proper game play.





Warning: The striker should never be elevated above the play surface during game play, this is considered an illegal move. Surface damage may occur if the edge of the striker makes contact with the play surface, leaving permanent scratches/scuff marks in the surface finish.
